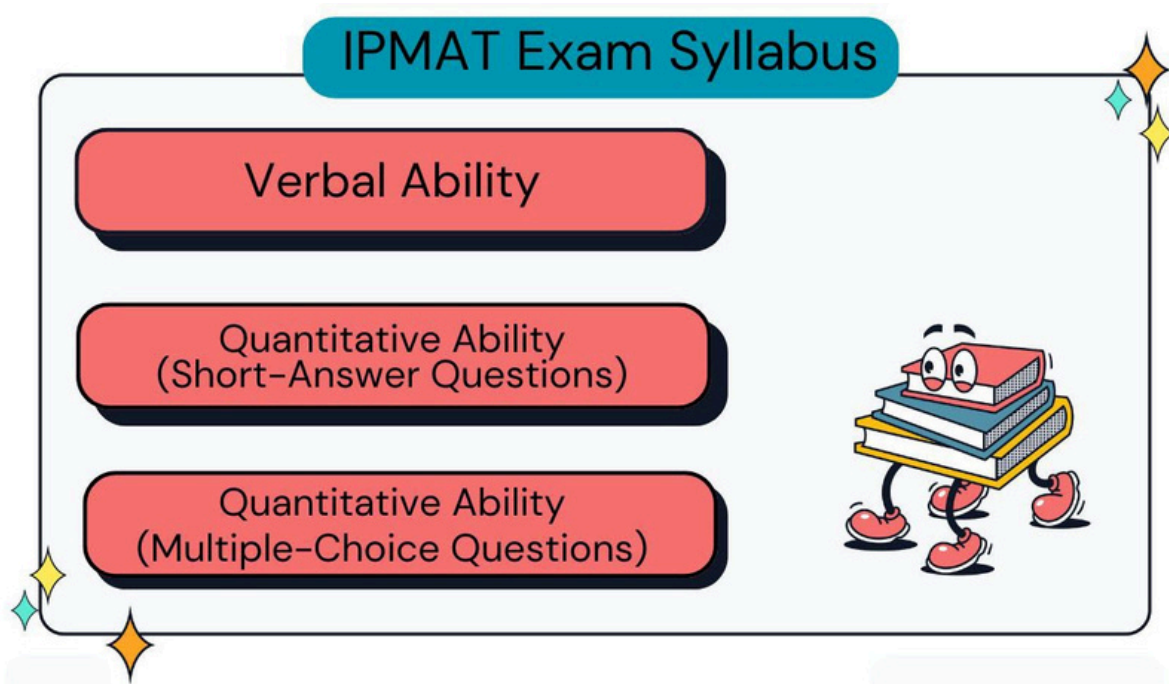


IPMAT 2025 Syllabus for IIM Indore

The IPMAT syllabus is prescribed by IIM Indore which includes section-wise topics and sub topics that the candidates should study to prepare for the IPMAT exam.

There are three sections in the IPMAT question paper based on Quantitative Ability and Verbal Ability.



IPMAT Indore Syllabus Overview

IPMAT question paper consists of three sections:

- Quantitative Ability (Multiple Choice Question-MCQ)
- Quantitative Ability (Short Answer Question-SA)
- Verbal Ability (Multiple Choice Question-MCQ)

Important Topics of IPMAT Syllabus

Section 1 and Section 2: Quantitative Ability

The Quantitative Ability sections of the IPMAT exam are divided into two parts, i.e. Short-Answer Type Questions and Multiple-choice questions. The QA sections tests the candidate's understanding mathematics and numerical ability. The important topics of the IPMAT syllabus in the QA sections are as follows:

Topic	Sub Topic
Number System	HCF & LCM, Surds & Indices, Factors, Simplification, Properties of Numbers, Finding Unit Digit, Roots
Algebra	Simple and Quadratic Equations, Logarithm, Functions & Graphs, Algebraic Formulae, Linear Equations, Inequalities
Geometry	Basics of Geometry, Mensuration, Angles, Lines, Graphs, Circle, Polygon, Coordinate Geometry, Triangles, Height & Distance
Arithmetic	Time, Work & Distance, Time & Speed, Averages, Partnership, Profit, Loss & Discount, Boats & Streams, Simple & Compound Interest, Ratio & Proportion, Age, Mixture & Allegations
Modern Maths	Probability, Vectors, Data Interpretation, Series, Arrangements, Sequences, Determinants, Permutation & Combination, Set Theory, Integration & Differentiation

Section 3: Verbal Ability

The Verbal Ability section of the IPMAT syllabus tests the student's proficiency in the English language skills and to ace this section, students should focus on improving their vocabulary and grammar use. Check below the important topics of Verbal Ability in the IPMAT exam:

Important Topic	Sub-topic
Vocabulary	Synonyms and Antonyms
Reading Comprehension	Reading passages based on inferences
Grammar	Sentence Completion, Prepositions, Conjunctions, Nouns, Pronouns, Modifiers, Tenses, Proper Usage of Words, Adverbs, Verbs, Parallelism
Logical Reasoning	Assumptions, Syllogisms, Deductive Reasoning, Logical Consistency
Other Topics	Idioms and Phrases, Etymology and Roots, Direct and Indirect Speech, Parajumbles, Foreign Words
