

IPMAT Indore Syllabus

Aptitude Test Structure:

1. There will be three sections in the Aptitude Test:
 - **Quantitative Ability (Multiple Choice Questions - MCQ)**
 - **Quantitative Ability (Short Answer Questions - SA)**
 - **Verbal Ability (Multiple Choice Questions - MCQ)**
2. **Marks Distribution:**
 - Each question will carry **4 marks**.
 - There will be a **negative marking of 1 mark** for each wrong answer, except for the Quantitative Ability (SA) section.
 - **Quantitative Ability (SA)** questions will not carry any negative marking.
3. **Time Duration for Each Section:**

Section	Time Duration
QA (MCQ)	40 minutes
QA (SA)	40 minutes
VA (MCQ)	40 minutes

4. **Section Order:**
 - Candidates must answer the sections in a pre-specified order. This order will remain the same for all candidates.
 - The above table does not indicate the final order of the sections.

Component	Score (Weight)
Score in Quantitative Ability (MCQ) Section	$25^* \left[\frac{\text{Candidate's Score} - \text{Minimum Score}}{\text{Maximum Score} - \text{Minimum Score}} \right]$
Score in Quantitative Ability (SA) Section	$25^* \left[\frac{\text{Candidate's Score} - \text{Minimum Score}}{\text{Maximum Score} - \text{Minimum Score}} \right]$
Score in Verbal Ability (MCQ) Section	$50^* \left[\frac{\text{Candidate's Score} - \text{Minimum Score}}{\text{Maximum Score} - \text{Minimum Score}} \right]$
Aptitude Test Score (ATS)	Sum of above

Note: Maximum and Minimum scores are the highest and lowest scores obtained in respective sections by the

candidates from the eligible pool.
